The week usually begins on Tuesday
at 10:00 AM and ends Friday at 12:30 PM.

The wages are \$520 per week for a 40 hour week.

Wages include all meals and housing from Tuesday-Friday work week.

We are looking for energetic and enthusiastic people who have a basic understanding of natural science, a love of the out of doors and experience working with children. The selected candidate will be willing to live on site during school operations and be responsible for a maximum of twelve 5th and 6th grade students, including sleeping in the cabin for the protection of the students. Cabin Leaders provide nurturing, discipline, science instruction, and safety awareness to the students. Being a positive role model is essential at all times.

The season begins October 28, 2019 with a full six days of training.

The season ends May 21, 2020.

We are closed the week of Thanksgiving and from Friday, December 19 until Tuesday, January 7th.

Completion of a CPR First Aid Card is required. If you do not have one, training will be provided. We are a drug and alcohol free work place and a mandatory drug test may be required at any time.

Essential Duties:

- Supervision with positive and clear communication to students.
- Maintain positive discipline and safety awareness.
- Direct and supervise students at all meals, bedtime, cabin clean-up and other group activities as requested by the Site Manager.
- Act as a role model at all times.
- Respond quickly and calmly to any emergency situations that may arise.
- Instruct and teach students on hikes and nature trails.
- Help organize and lead craft and recreational activities.
- Present lessons in an enthusiastic and understandable manner.
- Help and or lead entertainment in evenings, including songs, skits, bedtime stories, and s'mores.
- Supervise and direct students to good health habits including teeth brushing and showering.
- Provide any other duties applicable as requested by the Site Manager.

- A minimum of one year experience working with children.
- High School graduation required, college or university study desired.
- Spanish speaking is a plus.
